



FFI Login Process



As the world evolved and organizations incorporated higher levels of technology into their business practices, Friendship Force International has continued to operate on a system based on trust and goodwill amongst our members. Although this system continues today, it is important that we improve the organization with technology and processes that ensure greater security, privacy and confidentiality. As we grow, the steps we take together now will help ensure the integrity of what it means to be a member of Friendship Force International.

Why log in to Friendship Force online?

1. An online member experience ensures that information shared between members and clubs is secure and private.

Currently, information shared related to Journeys, payment transactions and clubs is sent by email or accessed through a publicly accessible page on the website. Although FFI has worked hard to ensure thatthis method of information sharing is safe, it remains unnecessarily vulnerable to cyberattacks and public exposure. Shielding this information behind a login and password drastically enhances the security of information sharing amongst members and clubs.

2. Adhering to the highest level of data protection means it is your data, not ours. And signing in to FFI online ensures this.

In 2017, Friendship Force International made a significant commitment to protecting Protection Regulation" and as a global organization with clubs where GDPR law applies, FFI is responsible for meeting these standards. What this means for you as a member is: a) your information will <u>never</u> be shared outside of Friendship Force with third parties, b) you will <u>always</u> have access to all the information being held by

Friendship Force related to your membership, and c) Friendship Force is committed to handling your data with care.

Better communication with Friendship Force International, the global network and within your club. Your online member experience is being built **in nine languages**, eventually with Friendship Force news streaming from the world and your region right to your dashboard. Whether it is highlighting a remarkable Journey story, promoting an upcoming conference, or getting updated on the latest news from your headquarters, signing in ensures you are always aware of what is happening within the Friendship Force.

1. In development: Journey and club management tools!

A future update will allow members to easily join Journeys or request information, communicate with Journey participants, and manage personal forms and financial information related to upcoming trips through the dashboard. Journey Coordinators will be able to approve participants who request to join a Journey and manage participant information as well as work more efficiently with FFI staff in promoting and organizing the Journey. Clubs will have the benefit of managing their own publicly visible information and be able to communicate virtually with their members.

- 2. **FFI Virtual Experiences** from educational webinars to online social gatherings with international frIn development: Accesiends.
- 3. Obtain your unique membership number that confirms your status as an *active* member with Friendship Force International whose membership is in *good-standing*.

Your Friendship Force member number accompanies every Journey, club and financial transaction and helps ensure that all your information is connected to you and a part of your member profile. Your membership number also enables your club, Journey coordinators and hosts to ensure that only those members who are active within the network and in good standing are participating in our programs.

Active means the member has paid their membership dues and is currently participating in local and international programs.

In good standing means that their membership has not been suspended, rejected or otherwise compromised. This important feature adds a layer of safety for traveling and hosting members by ensuring that only those who follow the code of conduct and embody the meaning of Friendship Force, are participating in the program.

How do I sign up?

Go to:my.friendshipforce.org

Click on the purple SIGN-UP button on the bottom right of the screen.

From there you will be guided through a few short questions to establish your online account. You are welcome to upload a picture and share as much information about yourself as you wish. The minimuminformation required for your account is (1) your name, (2) club/country of origin, and (3) a valid email address.

Frequently Asked Questions

A) Is it compulsory to sign-on to my.friendshipforce.org?

No, but it is highly recommended. Minimally, creating a sign-on will later allow you to view your current and future Journeys as well as manage your communication preferences.

B) Will I still be able to join a Journey if I don't sign-in?

Yes, FFI will create a member ID for you on receipt of your first financial transaction and this ID will be tied to your Journey participation.

C) How will others know I am an active member in good standing if I don't sign-in to FFI online?

If you don't create a member number by signing in, one will be created for you by your club or by FFI Staff upon receipt of your first financial transaction.

D) What information will be shared publicly when I create my online account?

Only information *you choose* to make public on the FF global directory, once it becomes active. By default, only FFI staff and your club's Club Admin will have access to this information.

E) Will others be able to change or edit my profile information?

FFI staff and your club's Club Admin will be able to update certain aspects of your account - information on yourbehalf, for example, if you request us to change your address or email.

- F) What if I don't sign up for my account online? Will an account be created that others can see? Yes, however only FFI staff and your club's Club Admin will have access to this information, which is your name, club and email address.
- G) I am not comfortable with technology. Can I still join in club and Journey activities? Yes! This new platform is meant to enhance your membership experience, not interfere with what you're comfortable with. Members in your club and our staff are always available to help. There will also be alternative processes, similar to how FFI currently operates, that will be available to those not comfortable with signing up.
- H) Will I be able to edit my profile right away once I'm signed up?

 No, first your club's Club Admin will need to verify you are a member of the club. After that, there will be a button in your account allowing you to edit your profile
- I)I didn't get the password reset email / automated confirmation email asking me to confirm my email address. What do I do?

First check your spam and trash folders in case it is there. Gmail users should also check a folder called "Promotions". If you don't see the email then go back to my.friendshipforce.org and there are links on the log in page to request a new password reset / confirmation email.

K) Who do I contact if I have other questions?

Our staff are ready to help you, so contact us any time.
